Patches and Fringe Scarf

*Keep yourself toasty warm with a colorful and uniquely stitched fleece scarf that looks like a long and narrow quilt. The stitching technique eliminates any bulk from the seams and allows the scarf to be reversible. Each end has a two-fabric patchwork block and an easy fringe finishes the narrow edges. With a little more fabric and time, this could be easily enlarged for a throw or bed covering.*

**You will Need- (Please read carefully)**

- **Fabric/Stabilizer**
  - 3/8 yard of fleece color A (print in sample)
  - 3/8 yard of fleece color B (solid in sample)
  
- **Threads**
  - Polyester sewing thread for construction to blend or contrast with fabric
  
- **Needles**
  - Size 90 Ball Point machine needle
  
- **Notions:**
  - Basic Sewing Notions
  - Scissors for cutting threads and fabric
  - Ruler with grid (6" x 24")
  - Rotary Cutter
  - Glass Head Pins

**Equipment**

- Sewing Machine in good running order, Electric Cord, foot control and manual
- Basic accessories that came with machine
- Edge-Joining or Stitch-in-the-Ditch Foot
